Henry Eisenhart is the Chair of the Department of Hospitality, Tourism and Family & Consumer Sciences. He has been at Georgia Southern University since 1991 and was on the faculty at the University of Oklahoma for 11 years prior to coming to GSU. Eisenhart has a bachelor's and a Master's degrees in Geography and a Ph.D in Recreation Resource Management.

He was formerly a city planner and Director of Parks and Recreation in Albuquerque, N.M. before embarking on a career in education. Dr. Eisenhart's research interests are in the sociology of sport and leisure; the management of sports organizations, and the design of the leisure environment. He has lectured in China, Australia, Hong Kong, Canada, Finland and throughout the United States. He and his wife Nanette, who is an Instructor of Latin in GSU's Foreign Language Department, have two children; Emily, a sophomore at the University of Georgia and Thomas, a junior at Statesboro High School.
